

Joint Steering Committee to the National Partnership for Remote Housing NT

Communique – Meeting #6



By mutual agreement, the sixth meeting of the National Partnership for Remote Housing Northern Territory Joint Steering Committee (JSC) was conducted as out-of-session, in lieu of a face-to-face meeting. Meeting papers were circulated to representatives from Anindilyakwa Land Council, the Australian Government National Indigenous Australians Agency, Central Land Council, Northern Land Council, Northern Territory (NT) Government, and Tiwi Land Council for consideration.

Program Progress Reports

The JSC noted the program updates provided by the NT Government. This included an indicative draft Capital Works schedule, a financial update and a program progress update.

The update included progress as at 31 October 2020:
